

Grade 11 Equivalent

A minimum of five (5) subjects passed at IGCSE level (Grades A-G), including English Language and/or the mother tongue. This does **NOT** constitute Matric.

The Cambridge Matric WITHOUT University Exemption - AS-Level Matric

In order to obtain a basic Matric without University Exemption the following options are available:

Option 1

A total of four (4) different subjects:
including three (3) IGCSE subjects Graded A to C
AND
one (1) Advanced Level at minimum Grade E

OR

Six (6) different subjects:
including five (5) IGCSE subjects Graded A to E
AND
One (1) Advanced Level at minimum Grade E

Option 2

A total of five (5) different subjects:
including three (3) IGCSE subjects Graded A to C
AND
Two (2) passes at Advanced Subsidiary (minimum Grade E)

OR

A total of seven (7) different subjects:
including five (5) IGCSE subjects Graded A to E
AND
Two (2) passes at Advanced Subsidiary (minimum Grade E)

The Cambridge Matric WITH University Exemption - AS-Level Matric

In order to obtain a Matric with University Exemption the following options are available:

Option 1

Minimum of four (4) AS-Level subjects passed on minimum Grade D
AND
at least one (1) IGCSE subject passed on minimum Grade C

Option 2

A minimum of two (2) A-Level subjects passed on minimum Grade E
AND
at least three (3) IGCSE subjects passed on minimum Grade C

Each of the above options must include either English Language, or the mother tongue as a first language.
