



The Lighthouse School Dress Code

We do not want to stifle the student's expression of identity and love that they have their own style. Focus should be on self-respect and respect for others. From Monday to Thursday students wear the school shirts and hoodies. These should be worn with plain pants or skirts and shoes. For excursions we will wear the uniform with dark denim and sneakers. Fridays are Civics Day, when students adhere to the following dress code.

APPROVED FOR SCHOOL WEAR

PANTS AND SHORTS

- Length must be appropriate

SKIRTS AND DRESSES

- Length must be appropriate or with leggings worn underneath;

SHIRTS AND BLOUSES

- T-shirts or sweatshirts must have no inappropriate writing, pictures, or graphics
- Shirrtails must be below the belt line even with arms raised above the head or when the student is seated;

UNDERGARMENTS

- Appropriate undergarments must be worn at all times.

NOT APPROVED FOR SCHOOL WEAR

- See-through clothing;
- Deep-scooped necklines;
- Articles of clothing which advertise or display the symbols of drugs, tobacco products or alcoholic beverages, profane or obscene language or symbols;
- Chains hanging from wallets or clothing;
- Exposure of undergarments of any type;
- Visible piercing type jewellery or paraphernalia (other than the ears) including tongue piercing is not allowed.
